教學綱要

The Purpose of this Course (教育目標) This course focuses on the theories from "New Criticism" through deconstruction and postmodernism. Theories are deemed as philosophical meditations on language. Different theories are literally different views of language; therefore they are not to be defined in binary opposition. Theories all together contribute to the understanding of literary texts and cultures. In this course, there are nine subjects to be expounded upon, enriched by a dialogue between reader and text. The course will be a form of intertextuality based on essential understanding of texts in theories. The student is expected to participate in class discussion for creating his own text. Every student is "responsible for" at least a seminar session and is required to submit a term paper to prove his comprehensive understanding of this course. Besides, the course will be carried on with a consciousness of English language-learning accompanying the study of literature and literary theories. The aesthetical or theoretical perspectives will enhance the vision of life relishing the subtlety of life. The students therefore will be expected to realize the theories do not merely work as systematic frameworks that tend to stifle sensibilities. Moreover, with the help of literary theories, the uses of words relevant to the life and literary contexts will be brought to the students' attention and practices of these words will be a major focus of this course. In a word, the spirit of the class is close reading, close reading of both literary texts and theories. By examining subtle details of the texts, the class helps the students cultivate their sensitivity to thoughts, language and life. Also, by interpreting a text based on close reading, the student demonstrates his ability of learning and teaching of core subjects of this course.
